

Kenderton School Uniform 2017-2018

Dear Parents,

When we prepare our children for school, we prepare them for life. Our number one job at Kenderton Elementary is to provide your child with a world-class education that prepares them for college and career. To ensure that all students are learning and thriving in a positive and safe environment, students will be required to wear the school uniform at all times. We work each day to encourage students to be successful at their job of learning. We ask that you do the same by supporting our standardized dress (school uniform). We believe standard dress has a positive impact on students' learning and behavior in and around the school, serves to unite students and increases school pride.

Kenderton Elementary students are expected to participate in our standardized dress.

Please read below to clarify what the standard dress should be to ensure that your child is in correct dress at the start of the new school year.

Students in K-5th

White or light blue Tops: Polo or oxford collared shirts (long or short sleeves) and sweaters/sweater vests for cool weather may be **navy**. **Navy ties for boys and navy crossies for girls.**

Navy Bottoms: Shorts, pants, skirts, jumpers, skorts, capris
Belts suggested for belt loops
Bottoms should fit properly and not sag below the waist

Navy leggings/tights are permitted underneath skirts in cold weather. No blue jeans under student's dress or skirt are acceptable.

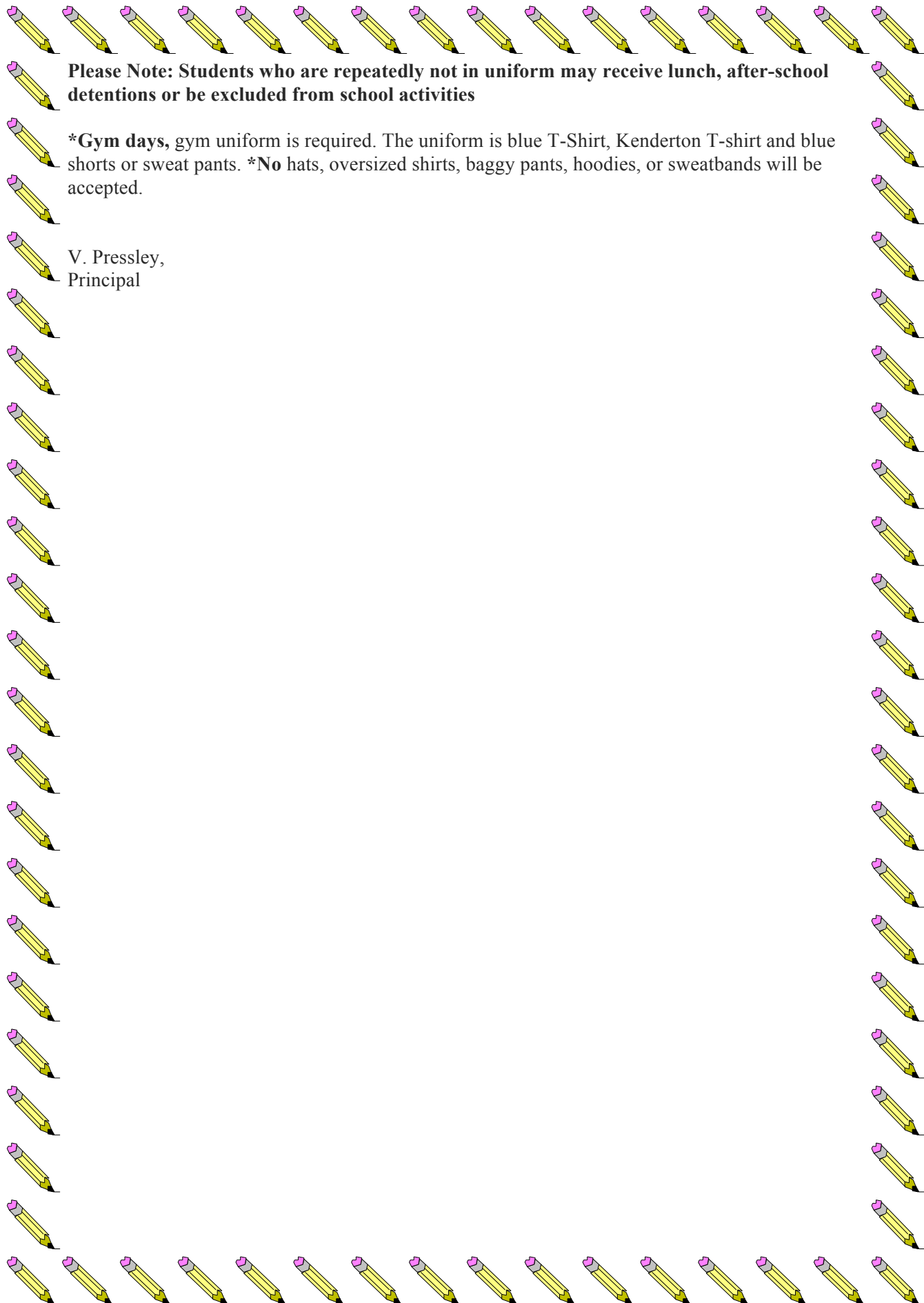
Students in grades 6th-8th: Middle Year Academy

White or light blue Tops: Polo or oxford collared shirts (long or short sleeves) and sweaters/sweater vests for cool weather may be **navy**. **Navy blue or navy plaid ties for boys and navy blue or navy plaid crossies for girls.**

Navy blue sweaters or blazers

Tan/ Khaki Bottoms: Shorts, pants, skirts, jumpers, skorts
Belts suggested for belt loops
Bottoms should fit properly and not sag below the waist

Navy or tan leggings/tights are permitted underneath skirts in cold weather. No blue jeans under student's dress or skirt are acceptable.



Please Note: Students who are repeatedly not in uniform may receive lunch, after-school detentions or be excluded from school activities

***Gym days**, gym uniform is required. The uniform is blue T-Shirt, Kenderton T-shirt and blue shorts or sweat pants. ***No** hats, oversized shirts, baggy pants, hoodies, or sweatbands will be accepted.
